During the year information regarding notification

from the Haryana Labour Welfare Board regarding the amendment/determination of salary limit for eligibility of welfare schemes and activities/awards run by Haryana Labour Welfare Board were circulated amongst the members.

EPFO remains committed to providing social security and retirement benefits to millions of employees across India. By enhancing accessibility through its online service portal, EPFO continues to improve ease of use and operational efficiency.

An interactive session with Shri S L Meena, Regional Director, Employees State Insurance Corporation, Ministry of Labour and Employment was organised at the Association office on 1st August, 2025. This session

provided information about a special scheme of Employees' State Insurance Corporation "SPREE

2025" - (Scheme to Promote Registration of Employers and Employees), other information related to ESIC and discussion on members grievances.

## Awareness session on ELI Scheme and Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PM-VBRY)





The Employment Linked Incentive (ELI) Scheme which was cleared by Union Cabinet, effective from 1st August 2025 as the "PM Viksit Bharat Rojgar Yojna (PM-VBRY)". The name is in alignment with the scheme's overall objectives towards the Vikist Bharat Initiatives and reflects the Government's commitment in generating inclusive and sustainable employment opportunities in the Country.

This scheme incentivizes employer to create new employment, aims to provide benefits for the generation of new job across various sectors with special focus on the manufacturing sector.

We were honoured by the presence of the following

dignitaries, who delivered insightful addresses on these newly launched schemes at Association office on 2nd August, 2025.:

- Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IAS, Principal Secretary, Youth Empowerment & Entrepreneurship and Labour, Government of Haryana.
- Shri Krishan Kumar, Regional Commissioner-II, Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO)

The session saw enthusiastic participation from our member industries.

Under this scheme every subscriber of EPFO is required to have an AADHAAR linked Universal





Account Number (UAN) which needs to be activated by creating login on the Member Portal for availing a number of facilities through a single window. The activation process is straightforward and can be completed using an Aadhaarbased OTP (One-Time Password) following a few steps. For availing the benefits of Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Scheme, the Bank Account number of the beneficiary is required to be seeded with AADHAAR so as to credit the benefits directly into the beneficiary's bank account.

## Litigation update: Haryana Employment of Local Candidates Act, 2020

As we knew the Association had filed objections against the Local Employment Candidate Act, 2020 in the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court. The case was related to requirement of employing 75% of the local candidates with respect to such posts where the gross monthly salary or wages are not more than Rs. 50,000/- or an amount as notified from time to time.

The Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court did not accept the logic of State Government that it will only affect State of Haryana and have no implication for union of India. As court order was not accepted by the Govt. of Haryana they filed a SLP on 18th January, 2024 against the orders of the Hon'ble Court in the matter.

The matter was listed on 18th November, 2024 before Registrar to complete pleadings which has been done for four respondents. The other respondents are yet to complete their pleadings once done it will come up for hearing.

### **Litigation update: Bonus Case**

The notification of the Central Government on the payment of Bonus with retrospective effect in 2016 was challenged. Having obtained a stay from the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, the case was transferred to the Hon'ble Supreme Court for a combined hearing, as many petitions from different areas were filed. During the hearing held on 16th Dec, 2024, the Hon'ble Supreme Court have referred to the Kerala & Madras High Court adverse orders. Holding that the Hon'ble Supreme Court mentioned that they need not interfere as the amendment to the Bonus Act has been implemented nationwide.

#### Nomination as Member Advisory Board Minimum Wages Act, 1947

Shri S S Sorot, Chairman, HR & ER Panel was picked as member of the Advisory Committee formed to discuss the amendments to minimum ages Act 1947, But, due to his unfortunate demise, the new Chairperson Shri Ram Avtar Aggarwal shall be taking up the responsibility further with the Committee.



The 16th Annual FIA-JCB Golf Tournament was held at Aravali Golf Club, Faridabad on 23rd March, 2025. JCB India Ltd. Over the years, this tournament has grown into a much anticipated annual event in the industrial town bringing together golf enthusiasts from across the Delhi NCR region. This year's tournament saw over 70 players competing across various categories.

Adding to the thrill, several new prize categories were introduced, including special awards for seniors above 70, youngest and oldest players, and those competing in the 9-hole format. A separate category for Professional/Amateur players also brought a competitive edge to the event. Participants teed off with enthusiasm for the prestigious FIA-JCB Rolling Trophy and other coveted prizes. The winner of the Tournament was Shri Ravinder Singh Vaswan with a Score of 78.











#### **CSR Panel**

Dr. Navdeep Chawla, Chairman was instrumental in steering the various CSR initiatives during the year. His dedication and support have played a vital role in the success of the CSR initiatives as under:-

#### **Mental Health Care Centre**

The contribution of Dr. Navdeep Chawla to provide medicines to poor OPD Patients needs to be lauded. Under his guidance the activities in our Mental Health Care Center (MHCC) increased manifold. Mental health Care centre is providing services at low cost to the patients having psychological problems and other mental health related conditions since 2012.

An increased number of 2902 patients visited during the year of 2024-2025, for psychiatry, clinical psychology OPD for medication, psychometric assessments and therapy. 1200 psychometric assessments were done including 692 Intelligence assessments and 508 other assessments which includes specific learning disability test, Autism test, OCD test, etc. Also, 266 patients were provided with therapies and 1436 patients were provided with psychiatric medications.

Supervision and guidance of clinical psychology students were undertaken where 8 students were guided during their internship.

#### **Donation to Juvenile Correction Homes**



During the year a request was received from a Social Welfare Centre in Faridabad for drinking water arrangements for inmates with R.O. for the "Place of Safety" under the Women and Child Development Department. In response to this, FIA Charitable Society has installed an 80L water cooler alongwith RO on 15th March, 2025 at Juvenile Correction Home.

#### Financial assistance to students

In a heartfelt gesture of support, FIA Charitable Society has extended financial support to DAV School,



Sector 14, Faridabad, with the objective of paying the part fees of 13 girl students who have either lost their father or both parents.

A contribution of Rs. 5,20,000/- is a significant step, in the organization's continued commitment to make a



positive impact on the community was provided to school authorities. FIA Charitable Society hope that this support will provide these girl students with the necessary financial support to focus on their studies and fulfill their academic dreams. Earlier in 2017, this project was undertaken by the FIA with the kind support of JCB India Ltd. It was for the first time in Haryana that a park of the size of Town Park has been handed over to a private a gency for development and maintenance; this was a matter of pride and honour for our Association. Later, the park was handed over back to the District Administration as the agreement between FIA & HSVP ended.

After completion of the renovation and maintenance work the inauguration was done on 5th May, 2025. The event was attended by village elders, Parents and children who appreciated FIA work. The Committee appreciated the efforts and support of Shri Harsh Gupta for the noble cause.

The month of November and December every year brings pressure on the NCR region, where it becomes difficult to breath and pulmonary diseases are on the increase. Faridabad



Industries Association and its members have been playing pivotal role in leaving the positive impact of its actions on the environment.

The Association is already continuously planting trees every year in and around its industries and public areas of the Industrial Town through its Clean and Green Panel.

Utilization of renewable energy and reducing dependence on fossil fuel is the demand of time and various Government agencies are driving this agenda nationwide. Faridabad Industries Association has also put in its bit towards this National Objective of "Go Green". The FIA has installed a 25 kWp Solar Power Plant at the roof top of FIA House, Bata Chowk. The inauguration of Solar Plant was done by Shri Mohan Gupta (Chairman) on 29 November 2024 in presence of EC members.

During the inauguration ceremony, Dr. Navdeep Chawla, Director FIA, said that the solar plant capacity has been so designed that it will not only reduce the present electricity bill of FIA office complex to zero but will also feed nearly 20% of its installed capacity back into the grid.



#### **MAMMOGRAPHY BUS**

The ambitious project of FIA Charitable Society, "Mammography Mobile Bus", has been serving the Society through organising the mammo tests with the help of various Rotary Clubs throughout the year. Breast cancer is the most common cancer among women in India, representing 27% of all cancers in women. It's a significant public health concern, with an estimated 1 in 28 women likely to develop breast cancer during her lifetime. While the incidence rate is higher in urban areas (1 in 22 women) compared to rural areas (1 in 60), the disease is rising in both. Early detection and awareness are crucial for improving survival rates.

Early detection of breast cancer can lead to early treatment options, and better chances of survival. Mammograms help in early detection of breast cancer. Mammograms can help save lives.

With the help of the mobile Mammography Van, which has been donated by the Rotary Club of Faridabad Mid Town to the FIA Charitable Society, we have organised various Mammography camps at different locations through different Rotary Clubs. For the year, 1100 Mammography tests were conducted.

## RENOVATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE AT FIA

Shri Raj Bhatia mentioned that the construction of the FIA building was done in 1971 for which all the past Presidents and members played their crucial role. He expressed his gratitude to Gupta Machine Tools, Premier Plasmotec Pvt. Ltd, Bony Polymers Pvt. Ltd, Vaishno Industries Pvt. Ltd. and C Dass Group, for the renovation and upgradationtion of the infrastructure and appealed to all members for continued active support.

The president dedicated the upgraded infrastructure to its members who may like to use facilities for conduct of training and other activities for benefits of their employees.

On this occasion, Past President and the Chairman of the CSR Panel, Dr. Navdeep Chawla mentioned that FIA has a special identity in Northern India due to its service and contribution. The continuous growth of the FIA resources is the dedication of its members to maintain the assets, name and fame of the Association.

He said that it is a matter of happiness for all of us that the FIA is not only promoting industrial development but is also fulfilling its moral responsibilities under which it is contributing to important issues like environmental protection and promotion of training and skill development.



hri G C Narang, Chairman and Shri Rajan Ghai, Co-chairman very efficiently handled all issues pertaining to day to day power problems and litigation at various levels.

Objections against Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) for the year 2025-26 were filed on behalf of our member industries. The Public Hearing was held on 15th January, 2025. A State Advisory Committee was also attened on 19th February, 2025 in the office of the Hon'ble Commission for the feedback/suggestion on the ARR/Tariff petitions of HPGCL, HVPNL, UHBVN and DHBVN. Shri GC Narang pressed the point that while the overall power supply position is far better but Industries are still facing lot of problem due to lack of a 24x7 power supply. Alternate sources of power like DG sets, cannot be used in NCR region due to implementation of GRAP of different levels from time to time. Medium and small industries are suffering badly.

In spite of our efforts, HERC issued a Tariff Order dated 28th March, 2025 with a steep hike in the power charges. The hike is going to impact the cost of



manufacturing.

A meeting was held at FIA on 11th April, 2025 regarding hike in the electricity tariff. The matter accordingly taken up with MD, DHBVN alongwith other issues on 5th May, 2025 at FIA. To protect the interest of industries. FIA made various representation to Hon'ble CM, Haryana including Power and Industries Department.

A follow up meeting was also held on 31.07.2025 at Chandigarh with the Hon'ble CM, Haryana regarding



the steep hike in power tariff. The matter is under active persuasion—with Government authorities through various plateform available. Hon'ble CM listen our appeal and asked for electricity additional data analysis of the impact for his review with department. The members have now decided parallel action of filing a review appeal at HERC for reconsideration of the hiked tariff and likely to be filed by the time this is reported in print.

#### Cases

• The panel members actively handled the issues related with the case filed in the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court regarding recovery of Old

Transmission Charges from OA Consumers revised from Rs.0.33/kWh to Rs.0.43/kWh) for the financial year 2016-17 and for the next 3 years vide HERC order dated 22.10.2019. However, the Hon'ble High Court Dismissed the case by saying that since statutory appeal before the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity (APTEL) is provided in the Electricity Act, the petitioners should avail the said remedy rather than directly approaching the High Court. The legal provisions available have been vetted by members and we have filed LPA at High Court.

- On behalf of our members, we have filed an appeal in "APTEL" against HERC Tariff Order dated 1st June, 2020 which affect consumers having power connection more than 66kV. The matter is still going on in the APTEL.
- The Association have filed a Appeal No. 82 / 2017 against the Tariff Order 2016-17, which was antiindustry, in the APTEL. The Tribunal has ordered both the Commission and the Utilities to expedite the Cost of supply (Voltage based), within 2 years for calculation of correct tariff.



## Meeting with **Shri A Sreenivas**MD, DHBVN

A meeting was held at the Association office on 4th May 2025. This meeting was chaired by Shri A Sreenivas, MD, DHBVN alongwith Director, DHBVN and SE, DHBVN, Faridabad. Meeting was attended by Shri Raj Bhatia, President FIA, Shri GC Narang, Chairperson and Shri Rajan Ghai, Co-Chairperson Energy & HERC Panel, Presidents and representatives of other industrial Associations of Faridabad attended the meeting. Amongst various issues, the need of 24 x 7 power supply, increased tariff and maintenance issues were discussed.













#### **GST & Income Tax Panel**



hri T. M. Lalani, Chairman & Shri Satish Bhatia, Co-chairman were instrumental in getting the difficulties of the members resolved from time to time. During the year following meetings were attended and organized:-

### Session on "Vivad Se Vishwas Scheme 2024"

Ministry of Finance, Government of India has brought out Vivad Se Vishwas Scheme 2024. The 2024 Scheme enables settlement of disputes pending as on 22 July



2024 under Income-tax Laws. As per the present Scheme, the taxpayer can settle their tax dispute by paying only the taxes due and getting waived off it's interest and penalty component (subject to the conditions). In many situations, taxpayers can settle their dispute by paying less than the taxes due on them. In view of this, a session was organized on 11th December, 2024 at FIA office to address the issues of Members.

- 2. The CGST Gurugram organised an Open House & Interactive Sessions for representatives of Trade and Industry with Shri Shashank Priya, Member (GST), Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs on 7th February, 2025 at Hotel Crown Plaza, Sector-



- 29, Gurugram. The session aims to foster dialogue between Taxpayers and CGST officials addressing key issues and facilitating a collaborative discussion of GST matters.
- 3. Shri Satish Bhatia, Co-Chairperson and Executive Secretary attended a meeting held on 7th April, 2025 at the State GST office, Faridabad under the chairmanship of Shri Devinder Singh Kalyan, Principal Secretary, Excise and Taxation department. They were informed during the meeting about the Haryana One Time Settlement Scheme for recovery of outstanding tax dues. The scheme was launched on 1st April 2025 and will stand for 180 days. This information was shared with all the member industries. The desirous members may take benefit.

#### Infrastructure Panel

his Panel under the Chairmanship of Shri B R Bhatia and Shri S S Banga, Co-Chairman resolved the problems of severe infrastructure being experienced by the member industries. They both remained active during the year in taking up infrastructure issues at various forums. During the year following steps have been taken towards improvement of infrastructural:-

1. Encroachment by Jhuggies in Sector 20A & 20B has been removed. The beautification of the land is



being done under the CSR Project. This project is undertaken with the contribution & support by



some members whose plots / office/Factories are located in the area.

2. Laying of water supply pipelines is currently underway from Gurugram's canal bridge to Atal



Park in Sector 25. This is being co-ordinated with HSVP & MCF officials.

3. Sewerage pipe work was Inaugurated at Sector 58 and sector 59 on 10th January, 2025. This work is in



progress from Atal Park, Sector 25, extending up to the Escorts warehouse in Sector 58.

4. Trenchless excavation work is being carried out in Sector 24. An underground water storage tank is



under construction in Sector 24 to ensure consistent water supply to industries in the area. Tiling work is being undertaken in Sector 24 along the stretches where sewerage pipelines have recently been laid.

5. The road construction work behind FIA, near



Gagan Cinema, and in the NIT Industrial Area near Hind Udyog Pvt. Ltd. has been completed.

#### **LADT Case**

The prolonged litigation and high Counsel fees have exhausted the collected funds and to sustain the



expense, the member's attention was drawn. Members have been informed about the excess funds

spent on the litigation and also reminded of their interest in continuing the litigation further at their end. Accordingly, a few meetings were held under the Chairmanship of the President, FIA and also facilitated the meeting of members and legal counsel in the month of April, 2025.

#### **Enhancement Case**

The Enhancement demand issue has been expedited repeatedly by the Panel Team. RTI application raised on 28th May, 2024 was replied by HSVP, Faridabad, on 20th March, 2025 in connection with information sought for sector 58 and sector 20B. The reply for sector 20A is still pending. This case had been expedited through Late Shri S. S. Sorot, Shri H L Bhutani and the secretariat team.

















## PRE BUDGET DISCUSSION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF HARYANA 2025-26

The Association presented the Pre-Budget points for 2025-26 in a meeting with various stakeholders, chaired by Haryana Government at the Public Works Department Rest House, Gurugram on 2nd January 2025.
